ENTRY ACCEPTANCE METHOD & OPENING DATE: Entries with postmarks BEFORE July 15, 2009 will not be accepted. Entry postmark date will be the determining factor for entry acceptance order. There is no need to overnight entries.

ENTRY DUE DATE: All entries must be received no later than August 31, 2009 at 6:00 p.m. Entries are limited to 400 total runs each day. Entries not correctly filled out or with an incorrect amount of fees will not be accepted. **We reserve the right to refuse any entry. Anyone who is not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry into the trial.**

ENTRY FEES: Full three days package per dog: \$140
Saturday and Sunday package per dog: \$125.00
Per Class Fee: \$12.00
Junior Handlers: \$5.00 per class

REFUNDS: There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Refunds are allowed if requested before the closing date, August 31, 2009. Refunds after the closing date will be honored only for bitches in season. A \$10.00 processing fee will be assessed for ANY refund. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, snow, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond our control.

ENTRY CHANGES: Accepted entries may be changed prior to September 8, 2009 at 9:00 p.m. Email change requests to Vickie Vander Vere at vcubed@chilitech.net or call 1-570-419-0872. The change request must identify dog, handler, dog's NADAC number, current classes entered, and the requested change. Saturday and Sunday move-ups do not constitute an entry change and will be happily accommodated!

NO CHANGES WILL BE MADE AT THE TRIAL
PLEASE READ OVER YOUR CONFIRMATIONS CAREFULLY.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com

MOVE-UPS between days will be permitted at this trial.

BAD CHECKS: Any person who writes a check for "insufficient funds" and/or otherwise a "bad check" will not be allowed to participate in this event until a money order or cashier's check for the amount of the original check; plus \$40.00 is received.

TENTATIVE REGISTRATION / START TIME: Registration for Friday will begin at 3:00. The first class on Friday will begin at approximately 3:45 - no earlier. Saturday and Sunday registration will begin at 7:15 AM. Briefings will begin at 7:30 AM with the first dog on the line immediately afterward. More information including the Friday afternoon/evening schedule will be provided in the show instructions.

CLEAN-UP at the show site is a must! You will be asked to leave the site and your scores will not be sent to NADAC if you do not clean up after your dog(s).

FOOD: No Concessions scheduled at this time. Check final show instructions for any changes.

AWARDS: First through fourth place ribbons will be awarded for each jump height in all categories, levels, and classes (except Chances which has no placements). Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for any qualifying run.

THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made and no scores will be submitted.

DIRECTIONS TO FACILITY

Animal Cracker Farm, 274 Berriman Hollow Road, Muncy, PA 17756

From the Northeast or East:

Take Interstate 80 West to Interstate 180 West (toward Williamsport, PA).

(*)From Interstate 180 traveling west, take Exit 10 (Muncy Main Street Exit). At the bottom of the exit ramp, go left toward Muncy. Travel approximately ¼ mile turn right on New Street just before the Muncy Drive-Thru Bank. (**)Follow New Street until the road comes to a “Y” and you will stay left. You will then go under an overpass. As soon as you go under the overpass, you will immediately turn right onto Muncy Exchange Road. Travel 2.5 miles and turn right onto Berriman Hollow Road (Some of the letters are missing on the sign). Follow Berriman Hollow Road and then go right up the driveway that displays the numbers 274. There will be blue and yellow ribbons tied on the post that displays the numbers 274. Follow the driveway to the top and around to the right and continue past the barn to the parking area.

From the West:

Take Interstate 80 East to Interstate 180 West (toward Williamsport, PA), then follow the (*)directions above.

From the South:

Take Hwy 15 North to Interstate 80 East. Take Interstate 80 East to Interstate 180 West (toward Williamsport, PA), then follow the (*)directions above.

From the North:

Take Hwy 15 South (to Williamsport, PA) to Interstate 180 East. Traveling East on I-180, take Exit 13A to Muncy. At the bottom of the exit ramp, go right. At the light, take a left onto Main Street. Go through the light at Penn Street and Main. Proceed on Main Street until you see the new Muncy Drive-Thru Bank and turn left onto New Street, then follow the (**)direction above from when you begin on New Street.

NON-JUMPING Classes: Non-Jumping Classes—Veteran or Disabled Handler. Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only.

The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course.

When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.

SKILLED CATEGORY: As of January 1, 2009 when entering the Skilled Category, all dogs must jump 4" lower than their Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires.

NADAC RULES: For more detailed information about new NADAC rules and classes go to www.nadac.com.

SCORING SOFTWARE: We utilize the Agility Unscrambled program which allows e-mail confirmations and results dissemination. Please help in keeping our costs and your entry fees as low as possible by CLEARLY including your e-mail address on your entry form.

WORKERS: We will have a workers board setup. Please sign up at the trial. We need everyone to volunteer to help ! THANKS

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the NADACagility@yahoogroups.com list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the www.NADACagility@yahoogroups.com list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records

AGREEMENT

- As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, Inc., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- Exhibitor/owner agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (including NADAC officers, directors, employees, and members, Canine Kinship, Curt and Vickie Vander Vere, (including its officers, agents, and employees), Animal Cracker Farm (including its officers agents and employees), In the Zone Agility, LLC (including its officers agents and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Exhibitor/owner hereby assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the afore-mentioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
